Emergency Response Action/Notification for Soil Erosion at Landfill 8.

Dear Ms. Fanelli:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) conducted an inspection of Landfill 8 on January 20, 2010. This inspection was performed subsequent to the construction management meeting in order to make a preliminary assessment of the impacts from recent storms. The inspection was also for an assessment of the damage which occurred as the result of erosion and slope failure along the south-eastern corner of the landfill.

In accordance with section 5.18 (Emergency Response Action/Notification) of the Consent Agreement, DTSC requests your response actions to include:


- Take all appropriate action to prevent further release and abate existing releases of sediments, contaminated soil and landfill material from landfill 8 at the Presidio, and shall complete these actions as soon as possible. The Trust shall take such action in consultation with the DTSC Project Manager and in accordance with all applicable provisions of the Consent Agreement.
- The Trust shall prepare a contingency plan in order to address potential releases from storm events in the near future. A copy of the contingency plan shall be provided to DTSC within seven (7) of this letter.
- Within seven (7) days of the release of sediments from landfill 8, the Trust shall furnish a report to DTSC, signed by the Trust's Project Coordinator, setting forth the events which occurred, and measures taken in response thereto.

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- The Trust is also requested to prepare a report providing an assessment of the impacts as a result of the release from landfill 8. This assessment report shall be submitted to DTSC within 30 days of this letter.
- Lastly, the Trust is hereby directed to provide a revised remedial design for Landfill 8 which contains an assessment of the surface water hydraulics for the site and adjacent area, and which provides for adequate site drainage and appropriate control measures to prevent future erosion events. This revised design shall be provided to DTSC within 30 days of this letter.
